5. Issue of the Transcript of Records

MK SKOPJEO1: Transcripts of Records (documenting credits earned at the UKIM) will be issued by UKIM. The UKIM will NOT automatically send your transcript to your home university. If the student's exam grades are not yet available when you leave, please make arrangements with the proper office to have your transcript sent to you.

BG SOFIA16: A Transcript of Records will be issued by TU faculties no later than [5] weeks after the assessment period has finished, but not later than 30 September 20XX of the Erasmus academic year (in effect as of 1 September 20XX -1.). Every student must pick up the transcript him/herself! The TU Sofia will NOT automatically send your transcript to your home university. If the student's exam grades are not yet available when you leave, please make arrangements with the proper office to have your transcript sent to you.

[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

6. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

The involved institutions agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. In the event of termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
